Donner Summit Public Utility District Lake Angela Algae Treatment

The Donner Summit Public Utility District water system (DSPUD) will be treating its source water (Lake Angela) by chemical addition (Cutrine-Ultra) to control algae. This will take place on Monday, September 21st at around 10:00 AM. This action was determined to be necessary to continue to supply quality drinking water to its customers and to eliminate the adverse effects that the algae is having on the treatment process.

What should you do?

You need not do anything. The chemicals being applied and their rates pose no public health concerns. The treated water leaving the plant is safe for public consumption and use.

What Happened?

For the past two years the district's source for drinking water has been affected by algae growth. The growth tends to begin in the spring and continue through the fall months. This has had a significant impact on the treatment plant's ability to effectively treat its drinking water. Staff has tried different chemicals and process controls with some success but as the warm season progresses and the algae gets worse these methods become less effective.

The best way to address the problem is to treat the lake and kill the algae before the treatment process.
