DSPUD Wastewater Treatment Plant Financing Options

Five potential scenarios will have varying financial impact on customers.

- A. USDA finances all—CWSRF Planning Loan and AccuWeb Loans are not refinanced.
- B. USDA finances \$5 million-Remainder with CWSRF. Planning loan is refinanced.
- C. USDA finances \$5 million—Remainder with CWSRF. Existing loans are refinanced.
- D. The entire financing is with CWSRF but only the planning loan is refinanced.
- **E.** The entire financing is with CWSRF and all existing loans are refinanced.

This information is for **DSPUD's share of the total Project cost**, which includes estimated planning and construction costs currently estimated to be \$22.7 million (\$13.7 million allocated to DSPUD and \$9.0 million to Sierra Lakes County Water District).
