Improvements to the DSPUD Wastewater Treatment Plant are necessary due to a new discharge permit issued by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region. The new permit, which includes new discharge requirements taking effect in April 2014, requires a higher level of treatment before effluent discharge into the Yuba River. Maintaining the health and pristine nature of the Yuba River has been a primary factor influencing the choice of proposed improvements. These upgrades will be extensive and will result in higher fees to rate payers.
