ORDINANCE 02-2020 OF THE DONNER SUMMIT PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT TO SET THE RECYCLED WATER RATE AND CHARGE

WHEREAS, the Donner Summit Public Utility District (District) in 2012 undertook the upgrade and expansion of the District's wastewater treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, the upgrade and expansion was completed in 2015 resulting in the facility producing a high quality treated effluent suitable for numerous uses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has analyzed and considered the current cost and expense of providing recycled water for such service; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above, the Board of Directors deems it necessary and has determined that its recycled water rate shall be determined by the previous year's audited wastewater expenses divided by the previous year's influent flow into the facility;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Directors of the Donner Summit Public Utility District as follows:

> Fiscal Year 2018/19 WWTF expenses Fiscal Year 2018/19 WWTF influent flow

\$1,269,569 73,000,000/1,000= 73,000 gallons

\$1,269,569/73,000 = \$17.39 per 1,000 gallons

This Schedule of Recycled Water Rate and Charge, as set forth above in this ordinance shall become effective April 21, 2020.
