



Assumed average interest rate of 5.5% with a 30-year term

2009

- LAFCO approves Annexation
- Properties required to connect to public sewer
- DSPUD provides water service

2015

- DSPUD completes wastewater treatment plant upgrade
- Treatment capacity available for Sugar Bowl East and West Villages

2018+

- DSPUD completes

 and West Villages
 Sewer Master Plan
- East Village owners construct public sewer
- Multiple West Village owners need public sewer in 2024.
